<ul> <li>Dinghies, Canoes and Kayaks must be owned by the member(s) and clearly identified with the member(s) last name on the hull</li> <li>Dinghy storage is restricted to non-motorized vessels not greater than 10 ft overall</li> <li>Kayak and Canoe storage is restricted to vessels not greater than 17 ft overall</li> <li>All stored vessels must fit on or into the rack allocated to the member(s)</li> <li>Storage racks must not be sub-leased, or used by anyone other than the member(s) to whom the rack has been allocated</li> <li>Flat rate dry storage fees as set by the Executive Committee must be paid when due</li> <li>Racks vacant for more than seven (7) days may be allocated temporarily to members wishing short term dry storage</li> </ul>			
I/We agree that all vessels stored at the DCYC docks shall be at the owners' risk and expense, and DCYC shall not be responsible under any circumstances for any loss or damage caused or sustained by such vessel.
